1. In order to “ping” hosts, you'll have to use the `-sP` argument. The following command instructs **nmap** to “ping” [www.slackware.com](http://www.slackware.com) and the 16 IP addresses starting at 72.168.24.0 and ending at 72.168.24.15.

```
darkstar:~# nmap -sP www.slackware.com 72.168.24.0/28
```

It should not be

```
darkstar:~# nmap -sP www.slackware.com 72.168.24.0/15
```
